

State of the Union 2025

10 SEPTEMBER 2025

Every year, the President of the European Commission delivers the [State of the European Union address](#) before the European Parliament, taking stock of the progress over the past year, addressing common challenges and presenting priorities for the year ahead, for Europe and beyond.

It is a key moment in our democracy - an opportunity to outline the EU's priorities and announce new initiatives.

The President presents her plans and sets the agenda for what the European Union should deliver to respond to the needs of Europeans, with concrete initiatives.

The 2025 State of the Union will be broadcast unencrypted and free of charge on the European Union's Broadcasting Service (EBS)

EBS is available through Satellite, via webstreaming on the Commission's Audiovisual Portal (<https://audiovisual.ec.europa.eu/en/>) or via social media.

Please find below the technical details for each transmission mode.

1. EBS via satellite

EBS and EBS+ are available with these parameters using a satellite receiver:

Satellite	Eutelsat 9B – 9°E
Transponder	E10
Downlink frequency	11900 MHz
Polarization	Horizontal
Standard	DVB-S2
Modulation	8PSK
Symbol rate	27.500
FEC	2/3

Both TV programmes contain the original audio and interpretations **in all 24 official languages** of the EU Member States. For more information visit: <https://audiovisual.ec.europa.eu/en/aboutebs>

The State of the Union will be broadcast on both EBS and EBS+ channels:

- EBS+ will broadcast the original video signal
- EBS will broadcast an ‘*enhanced*’ version (integrating social media, quotes and illustration footage)

We also offer the transmission to the European Broadcasting Union (EBU).

Radio broadcasters can use either EBS or EBS+ to receive, decode and re-broadcast any of the available audio tracks. Please note that these audio tracks are not available as individual audio services.

2. EBS via web streaming

To stream SOTEU on a webpage, you can directly embed the EBS or EBS+ live players by using the following embed codes:

- enriched version (with graphics and illustrations)

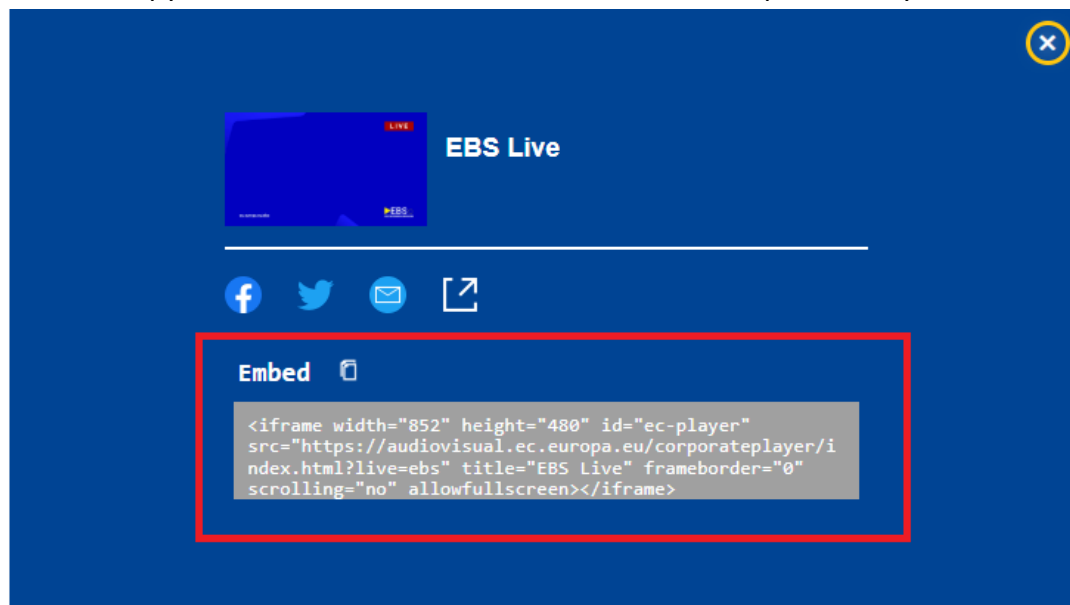
The default language is the original, but you can choose a different one.

To configure the player's parameters, go to the webpage of our live players and copy the code with your preferred choices as explained below:

Click on the top right of the player on the INFO button



You can copy the iframe code in the section "Embed" and paste into your website.



The embed code is permanent (it will always show the current broadcast) and can thus be already pre-programmed on the target page (and turned on when the SOTEU begins).
