Hollannissa susi on hyökännyt ihmiseen vuoden ajanjaksolla viidesti (7/2024-7/2025). Neljässä tapauksessa viidestä kyseessä on ollut sama susi.

Kolmessa tapauksessa uhrina on ollut lapsi.

Hollannin aineistosta löytyy muun muassa tuoreita linkkejä Hollanin yleisradio NOSin artikkeliin ja videoon viime heinäkuun hyökkäyksestä.

Italiassa viranomaiset raportoivat 23 susihyökkäystä vuodesta 2011 alkaen.

Tämä aineisto on saatu FACEsta syyskuussa 2025.

Aineiston kieli on englanti.

Lähdemateriaalia löytyy hollanniksi ja italiaksi.

List of wolves attacks in the Netherlands 2024 – 2025

There were 5 wolf attacks (4 bite incidents and 1 runover).

In 4 cases it is the same wolf.

July 16, 2024 and **July 31, 2024** and **May 19, 2025** and **July 30, 2025**= GW3237m **April 13, 2025** = GW4655m

Apart from the human attacks, there are a lot of livestock attacks. In recent years, the number of wolf attacks on farm animals, particularly sheep, has increased sharply. In the 2024 damage year, 758 compensations for wolf damage were granted, compared to 433 in the 2023 damage year. The total amount of compensation has also risen significantly: in 2024, €876,092 was paid out, compared to €367,542 the previous year.

Involved	A young girl from a after-school care group.
Nature of Incident	A wolf approached the girl from behind and bit her in the side. The wolf released the girl immediately; she fell and sustained minor injuries.
DNA	Wolf DNA confirmed on the girl's clothing.

Context:

On July 16, a child was bitten by a wolf while playing with a group from an after-school care center at the Den Treek nature reserve. According to the supervising adults, the wolf approached the child from behind and bit her in the side. The animal let go immediately, but the incident caused the child to fall and sustain minor injuries.

At the time, the province was unable to confirm whether a wolf was involved. However, subsequent forensic analysis of the girl's clothing has confirmed that the bite came from a wolf. The individual animal could not be identified.

Den Treek is known to be home to a female wolf and her cubs. According to provincial authorities, this wolf is known to display defensive behavior, particularly toward people and dogs that come too close.

Context

On July 31, 2024, provincial authorities issued an urgent warning after a child was reportedly knocked over or pushed by a wolf near Austerlitz. The report came from the province of Utrecht and was considered a possible second incident involving a child and a wolf in that area.

Local municipalities—including Leusden, Woudenberg, Utrechtse Heuvelrug, and Zeist—urged people not to bring small children into the forested areas for the time being.

Wildlife experts described the animal's behavior as "atypical and disturbing," leading the province to consider the animal responsible for earlier incidents in nearby Leusden (involving another child and a dog) and prepare a permit to shoot it.

DNA tests confirmed it was wolf: GW3237m

It has recently become possible to shoot this individual wolf, for which a permit has been granted by the province. This has been approved by the court.

The province of Utrecht is permitted to shoot the wolf that has been causing problems on the Utrechtse Heuvelrug with a firearm. This was ruled by the preliminary relief judge of the District Court of Midden-Nederland. Utrecht, 23 July 2025

Context:

On Sunday, April 13, 2025, a wolf attack occurred in Hoge Veluwe National Park in the Netherlands.

A woman was jogging on a marked trail when she was bitten twice in her leg by a wolf. Bystanders intervened and chased the wolf away, after which the victim was taken to hospital.

The wolf involved in the April 13, 2025 incident has been identified as **GW4655m**.

- The **province of Gelderland** issued a **permit to shoot and kill** this wolf after it was officially labeled a "problem wolf" due to the attack on the jogger in Hoge Veluwe National Park.
- The decision was legally challenged by animal rights groups, but the **court upheld** the permit, stating that public safety outweighs other considerations.
- As a result, it is currently lawful for authorities to kill wolf GW4655m.

On May 19, 2025, an incident occurred in the Netherlands where a woman was bitten by a wolf in the Den Treek-Henschoten nature reserve near Leusden, Utrecht.

- The wolf, known as GW3237m, attacked the woman while she was walking, biting her twice on the leg.
- DNA analysis confirmed it was indeed this wolf.
- This followed earlier reports of abnormal behavior from the same wolf, including an attack on a child in 2024.
- Due to these repeated attacks, the Utrecht province was granted permission by the court to euthanize the wolf to prevent further incidents.

Context:

On July 30, 2025, at Den Treek-Henschoten estate near the Pyramid of Austerlitz in the Utrechtse Heuvelrug, a 6-year-old boy was bitten and briefly dragged into the forest by a wolf

identified as GW3237m, which had been involved in previous incidents in the area. Bystanders managed to chase the wolf away using sticks, and the boy sustained injuries to his back and armpit before being taken to the hospital. This wolf had already been classified as a problem wolf by the province of Utrecht due to earlier attacks. The province had issued a permit to kill GW3237m and warned visitors to exercise caution, particularly with children and dogs. DNA analysis conducted by Wageningen University & Research (WUR) later confirmed that GW3237m was indeed the wolf involved in this incident.

List of attacks presented by Francesco Bruzzone to the Chamber of Deputies on 31/07/2023

Except for the attacks from 2023 in Vasta, there was no DNA identification.

List of attacks on people resulting in injuries and/or torn clothing or shoes:

- 2011 Sedico (Belluno): Attack on a young man who was walking dogs at night with his partner near their home (wooded area). The man suffered facial injuries requiring multiple stitches on both cheeks; one cheek was pierced. No investigation, no swab tests, no search for a wolf. No attribution to dogs. Complete silence. Likely, the forest rangers knew it was a wolf. Wolves had in fact been sighted nearby and predations had occurred.
- **2011 Farindola (Pescara):** A shepherd was attacked by a wolf and bitten on the calf; he took refuge in a tree.
- **2013 San Venanzo (Terni):** A man was attacked near a flock of sheep. His clothes were torn.
- 2015 San Benedetto dei Marsi (L'Aquila): A man was attacked by a wolf while refueling at a gas station and sustained injuries. The case was denied, but Franco Zunino (former director of the Abruzzo National Park), after interviewing witnesses and journalists, received confirmations. So unlike other cases where denial could be credible, this one remains on the list.
- **2016 Solignano (Parma):** Attack on a shepherd guarding a flock. The wolf bit a boot. Guard dogs were present.
- **2017 Giaveno (Turin):** A man walking his dachshund was attacked by two wolves. His pants were torn and the dog was injured. DNA analysis on the pants confirmed the attack was by an Apennine wolf (ISPRA-confirmed).
- **2020 Otranto (Lecce):** In a tourist village, a wolf attacked a 6-year-old girl and tore her dress.
- 2020 Otranto (Lecce): The same wolf attacked a 47-year-old tourist on the beach. She suffered injuries to her back and arms. The wolf, confirmed by ISPRA to be such, was captured and placed in a facility. Piero Genovesi from ISPRA refuted the fake news that the wolf was kept in captivity it was a regular Apennine wolf.

- **2020 Baselica (Piacenza):** A farmer working in his field was attacked by a wolf, which tore his pants.
- **2021 Malborghetto (Udine):** A hybrid wolf from the Tarvisio pack attacked a young man inside his house while trying to prey on the dog. The man injured his hand defending the dog.
- **2022 Marsciano (Perugia):** A hunter training his dog was attacked by a wolf and sustained head and leg injuries. The dog was also injured.
- **2022 Vasto (Chieti):** First attack by the "Vasto wolf." A tourist from Mantua was attacked on the beach and suffered leg injuries.
- 2022 Vasto (Chieti): A man walking on the cycle path was attacked by the wolf and sustained an arm injury.
- **2022 Alessandria (San Bartolomeo suburb):** A woman walking on a city street was attacked by a wolf that tore her pants.
- 2023 Vasto (Chieti): On the beach, a wolf attacked a 4-year-old girl, leaving bite marks on her back. Her father pulled her away, and the wolf then attacked another child.
- **2023 Vasto (Chieti):** Another beach attack on a 46-year-old woman. She suffered a thigh injury.
- **2023 Porcari (Lucca):** A 50-year-old woman walking her dog in a suburban area sustained hand arm injuries from a wolf attack. The dog was also injured. The woman, who had already seen wolves, excluded the possibility of domestic dogs.
- 2023 Palombaro (Chieti): A 56-year-old woman, Nadia Terenzi, was attacked while
 walking her small dog in the town center. The wolf snatched the dog from her arms and
 knocked her down, fracturing her wrist. The dog was dragged toward the woods,
 leaving a trail of blood.
- **2023 Vasto (Chieti):** Another beach attack on a 24-year-old woman, who had to go to the emergency room for minor injuries.
- **2023 Vasto (Chieti):** A 15-year-old boy was attacked. He stood on a beach chair screaming, but the wolf bit his leg. He then used the chair to defend himself.
- 2023 Vasto (Chieti): Attack on two young lovers from Foggia (him: 20, her: 18). It was the most dramatic episode on Vasto marina beach. The boy defended himself for a long time and confirmed it was not a dog due to the elongated snout. After letting go, the animal chased and injured the girl too. The boy sustained leg and arm injuries; the girl had injuries to her buttocks. According to the couple, the attack lasted an hour, and they feared the worst.
